The Village Administrator reported on the following: 1) The north-south alley located north of State Route 12 and between the Sibold and Hartzler properties -- This alley has one residence and is experiencing difficulty in receiving parcels since this is not a named street. This alley should be a continuation of Pearl Street to the intersection of Davy Street. It was the consensus of the Council to begin the process of naming this alley North Pearl Street. 2) Due to the sewer project on Heather Lane, some of the curb and gutters will also need to be replaced. Since some of these curb and gutters are in poor condition, discussion was had as to replacing all of the curb and gutters on Heather Lane from the intersection at North

Jefferson Street to the blacktop on Heather Lane. The estimated cost is \$15,000. It was the consensus of the Council if the cost for this project is not over 10% of the \$15,000 estimated, to proceed with replacing said curb and gutters of the said portion of Heather Lane.

The Village Administrator also reported Kelly Ward, Director of the Putnam County Library, will be present at the September 22, 2009 Council meeting. She wants to reassure the Council there are no plans to close the Branch Library in Pandora.

The Elizabeth Huston Platting was presented to Council. A small strip of land, 1984 square feet, owned by Dennis Westrick, is being added to Outlot No. 19 owned by Donald and Elizabeth Huston. Motion was made by Mr. Vance, seconded by Mr. Fricke to approve said Elizabeth Huston Platting. Voting: All Yea.

Motion was made by Mr. Vance, seconded by Mr. Hall to excuse Mr. Painter and Mr. Blank from this meeting. Voting: All Yea.
