Motion was made by Mr. Hall, seconded by Mrs. Stall to approve the bills as presented. Voting: All Yea.

The Village Administrator reported on the following: 1) The Hilty Home would like to have a petting zoo for the Child Care Center. It was the consensus of the Council to grant permission for a petting zoo for the Child Care Center. 2) The Fire Department has been awarded \$101,000 FEMA Grant. This grant is to be used for equipment and training. The Fire Chief stated to Mr. Schneck they will be buying a cascade system, turnout gear, boots and other equipment. As to the cascade system, since it takes up a lot of room, the Fire Chief, Jason Kinsinger asked if another bay could be added to the Fire Station building to house the

EMS ambulance and equipment. Thus, the current EMS bay would be utilized for the cascade system. Discussion was had as to seeking estimated costs for this additional bay. Mr. Schneck will be contacting several contractors who specialize in metal buildings as to this project. Also Fire Chief, Jason Kinsinger, will be at the next council meeting to discuss this matter further.

The Community Center Committee has turned over the playground to the Village to maintain. Also the remaining balance in the Playground Fund of \$166.44 was remitted to the Village to be used for maintenance expenses of the playground.

Discussion was had as to the Kevin Peth property located at 109 South High Street. This property suffered a fire previously and was to be sold at Sheriff's sale, but the owners filed bankruptcy, so at the present time everything is on hold. Discussion was had whether this residence would fall under the village's ordinance regarding unsafe structures. Village Solicitor, Michael Borer, stated since the owners have filed bankruptcy, the Village may not be able to have this property declared unsafe, but the owners could be notified to clean up around their residence. It was the consensus of the Council for Mr. Borer to send a letter to the Peths to clean up outside around their property.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned upon a motion by Mr. Vance, seconded by Mr. Fricke. Voting: All Yea.
