Motion was made by Mrs. Stall, seconded by Mr. Painter to place Resolution No. 2010-593 on its first reading. Voting: All Yea.

The Village Administrator reported on the following: 1) Received a letter from Robert Lee as to the poor restoration job performed by the contractor on the sewer project. More specifically, the replacement of dirt and the seeding of grass. There are other residents who also have expressed their displeasure as to this matter. Poggemeyer Design Group, engineering firm for said project, has so been notified and this matter will be addressed in the Fall. 2) Since Marvin Steiner, due to his accident last month, will be off work for an extended period of time, Ohio EPA stated the Village will need to contract with an individual who is licensed, both in water and wastewater. This is required to be in compliance with Ohio EPA regulations. Thus, the Mayor and Village Administrator have contracted with the Village of Columbus Grove for their employee, Jeff Vance, who is licensed in water and wastewater, at the rate of \$50 per hour. Mr. Vance will be overseeing the water and wastewater systems for a minimum of three hours each week. 3) Received one bid from Ward Construction as to street, alley and catch basin repairs. The total bid for all listed repairs is \$182,414.00. The Council went through the bid sheet and approved the following items: Street Overlay: A-1 for \$9,100.; A-3 for \$2,800.; A-5 for \$10,500.; Patch Work: C-1 for \$175.; Curb/Gutter Repair: D-1 for \$6,240.; D-2 for \$13,206.; D-3 for \$16,628.; D-5 for \$1,240.; D-6 for \$1,500.; Street Repair by Catch Basins: E-1 for \$2,350.; D-3 for \$3,000.; D-4 for \$1,850. The total project cost is \$68,589.

Motion was made by Mr. Painter, seconded by Mrs. Stall to excuse Mr. Vance and Mr. Hall from this meeting. Voting: All Yea.
