A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE PARK FUND. Motion was made by Mr. Fricke, seconded by Mr. Vance to place Resolution No. 2010-591 on its second reading. Voting: All Yea.

The Village Administrator reported on the following: 1) In the future when there is a ball game and a tornado warning has been given, the coaches are to contact the local police department who then in turn will open up the Community Center for emergency shelter. 2) Received a quote from A & M Sealers as to re-surfacing the fire station lot. To seal the cracks-\$620.00 and for re-surfacing-\$669.00 for a total of \$1,289.00. It was the consensus of the Council to hire A & M Sealers for this project.

The Street Committee will meet with the Village Administrator on Wednesday, June 23, regarding street repairs for this year.

Councilman, Jon Hall, suggested for a future project, a storage facility at the Park to house equipment such as drags for the ball fields as well as other items.

Police Chief, Scott Stant, presented to the Council a proposed contract between Barbara Ross and the Pandora Police Department in regards to writing a grant for police equipment. Ms. Ross' retainer fee is \$600, which is non-refundable. The specific grant Chief Stant is requesting Ms. Ross to pursue is an Ohio JAG Grant for law enforcement. Chief Stant would like to use the grant for the purchase of digital cameras and laptops for the cruisers. It was the consensus of the Council for Chief Stant to enter into this contract with Ms. Ross.

Discussion was had as to the \$.25 per hour wage increase for the employees approved at the last meeting. In checking the current wage and salary ordinance this increase is not in compliance with the current wage scale. Thus, a motion was made by Mrs. Stall, seconded by Mr. Painter to approve a \$.30 per hour wage increase for the employees and to make it retroactive June 7,2010. Voting: All Yea.
