The Village Administrator reported on the following: 1) The village building on Basinger Road is in need of ventilation and insulation in the attic. It was the consensus of Council for three roof vents be installed soon and insulation be installed prior to winter. 2) Presented a proposal for the purchase of a 2011 Ford F-250 4x4 8-foot bed with regular cab truck.
