RESOLUTION NO. 2011-607: A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A DRUG ENFORCEMENT FUND TO SUBSIDIZE THE AGENCY'S LAW ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS THAT PERTAIN TO DRUG OFFENSES, PROVIDED BY MANDATORY FINES PROVIDED UNDER ORC 2925.03(D)(1) AND ANY FINE OTHER THAN A MANDATORY FINE THAT IS IMPOSED FOR A VIOLATION PURSUANT TO DIVISION (A) OR (B)(5) OF SECTION 2929.18 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE TO THE COUNTY, TOWNSHIP, MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OR PARK DISTRICT, AS CREATED PURSUANT TO SECTION 511.18 OR 1545.04 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE OR STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES IN THIS STATE THAT PRIMARILY WERE RESPONSIBLE FOR OR INVOLVED IN MAKING THE ARREST OF, AND IN PROSECUTING, THE OFFENDER. Motion was made by Mr. Fricke, seconded by Mrs. Stall to place Resolution No. 2011-607 on its second reading. Voting: All Yea.

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-608: RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR. Motion was made by Mr. Vance, seconded by Mr. Hall to place Resolution No. 2011-608 on its first reading. Voting: All Yea.

The Village Administrator reported on the following: 1) The lift station on State Route 12 and Rocket Ridge is in need of repair. The variable frequency drives need to be replaced. The estimated cost to replace said equipment is appoximately \$8,000. Discussion was had as to the high cost to replace said equipment. The Council suggested to contact Sarka Electric for a cost estimate to repair said lift station. 2) Received two quotes regarding the addition to the fire station to house the cascade system: Schroeder Steel (Golden Giant contractor)-\$14,000.00. This quote does not include the overhead door and electric. The second quote received is from M & W Construction-\$23,859.00, which includes the overhead door, but a double door, which would be more energy efficient. The Council requested for the Village Administrator, Stanley Schneck, to contact Schroeder Steel and compare his quote with M & W Construction to be sure the quotes are comparable as to materials. Also Mr. Schneck is to contact Fire Chief, Jason Kinsinger, as to this proposed addition, which is to only house the cascade system. It was the consensus of the Council, if the quotes received are primarily the same as to size of addition and materials used, the Village Administrator is to hire the amount of \$13,900. The material used would only be a cosmetic type repair and would not address the real cause of the deterioration. Thus, it was the consensus of the Council to obtain quotes from masonry contractors regarding this proposed project.

Motion was made by Mr. Vance, seconded by Mr. Fricke to excuse Mr. Painter from this meeting. Voting: All Yea.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned upon a motion by Mrs. Stall, seconded by Mr. Vance. Voting: All Yea.
