Motion was made by Mr. Painter, seconded by Mr. Hall to approve the bills as presented. Voting: All Yea.

The Village Administrator reported on the following: 1) As to the dirt pile on Basinger Road, Allied Environmental has planted some grass seed in various areas and re-shaped the pile after removing the dirt for another project. 2) Received quotes from ward Construction as to various street repairs. It was the consensus of the Council to hire Ward Construction to do the following: a) repair various patches and trenches for a total of \$2,075; b) alley between Main Street and intersecting alley-sunken trench - \$200; c) Basinger Road from Madison Avenue to South Avenue - \$3,850; d) Basinger Road from Madison Avenue to South Avenue -\$49,200; e) repair a portion of South Avenue from Basinger Road to South Jefferson Street for approximately \$5,000. Thus the total for street repairs is approximately \$60,325. 3) Reported on the cost of replacing water meters as presented by three separate companies. It was the consensus of the Council for the Water/Sewer Committee and Jeff Vance, the village's water/sewer operator of record, to meet with these companies and report to the Council.

Police Chief, Scott Stant, stated to the Council Andrew Probst who was hired last month as a full-time police has resigned effective May 1, 2013 for personal reasons. Chief Stant recommended to the Council to hire part-time officer, Kyle Hall, as a full-time officer. Motion was made by Mr. Vance, seconded by Mrs. Buess to move to Executive Session to discuss personnel matters. Voting: All Yea. (Time:8:15PM). Motion was made by Mr. Vance, seconded by Mr. Fricke to move from Executive Session to Regular Session. Voting: All Yea. (Time:8:35PM).

Motion was made by Mr. Vance, seconded by Mr. Swary to hire Kyle Hall as a full-time police officer, at the wage rate of \$12.00 per hour, effective Monday, May 20, 2013. Voting: Swary-Aye; Painter-Abstain; Vance-Aye; Fricke-Aye; Hall-Abstain, Buess-Aye.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned upon a motion by Mr. Fricke, seconded by Mr. Painter. Voting: All Yea.
