The Pandora Village Council met in Regular Session on Tuesday, September 26, 2017 at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building with Mayor John Schlumbohm presiding.

Members Present: Klingler, Liechty, Braidic, Tadena

Members Absent: Burkholder, Eisenbach

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Mr. Klingler, seconded by Mr. Tadena, to approve the September 12, 2017 minutes. Voting: All Yea.

Motion was made by Mrs. Braidic, seconded by Mr. Tadena, to approve the bills as presented: Total non-payroll of \$6,057.24 and Payroll of \$17,091.82 for a total of \$23,149.06. Voting: All Yea.

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-653: RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR. Motion was made by Mr. Liechty, seconded by Mr. Tadena, to adopt Resolution No. 2017-653 as read for its third and final reading. Voting: All Yea.

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-654: RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE PARK FUND. Motion was made by Mr. Klingler, seconded by Mr. Tadena, to adopt Resolution No. 2017-654 as read for its third and final reading. Voting: All Yea.

Council reviewed and discussed the street repair quotes from ward Construction Co. Motion was made by Mr. Klingler, seconded by Mr. Tadena, to approve Ward Construction to do the following repairs, per the attached quotes; 3,7,8,9,12,15a,16,17,18,19a (with the Township's portion of Madison Ave. being \$13,672.40) at a total village cost of \$48,341.32. Voting: All Yea.

Village Administrator, Rick Morrison, reported on the following: 1) Mayor and Administrator met with Nu Systems and signed an agreement. Hopeful that within one year we will begin seeing some results and within three years seeing significant results. They will begin installing a shed and their equipment on October 3rd. The fee for their service will be \$1,420.00 per month and the agreement can be cancelled at any time. Nu Systems provided detailed, printed information on their product and service which will be forwarded to the EPA as part of the village's action plan for resolving reported violations. 2) The roof at the shop has been coated. 3) The commercial water meter at ADS has been installed. 4) The wet well and lift station has been washed out. 5) It was the consensus of Council to approve the purchase of a 12 ton forward lift hoist in the amount of \$6,430.00 including installation. 6) It was determined by village Solicitor, Scott Basinger, that there are no parking restrictions at the location on Monroe Street that was discussed at the last meeting. Therefore, Council asked Mr. Morrison to move forward with installing the "No Parking Signs" but to first inform the resident that these signs will be installed.

Council discussed a request by Dan Radebaugh to sell a section of the Industrial Park to him in order to square off his lot. It was the consensus of Council to reject this request as this land is for the purpose of job development.

Mayor Schlumbohm gave an update on the funding for the Community Center Restroom Project stating that it was moving slowly through the State to receive the \$40,000.00 in grant funding.
